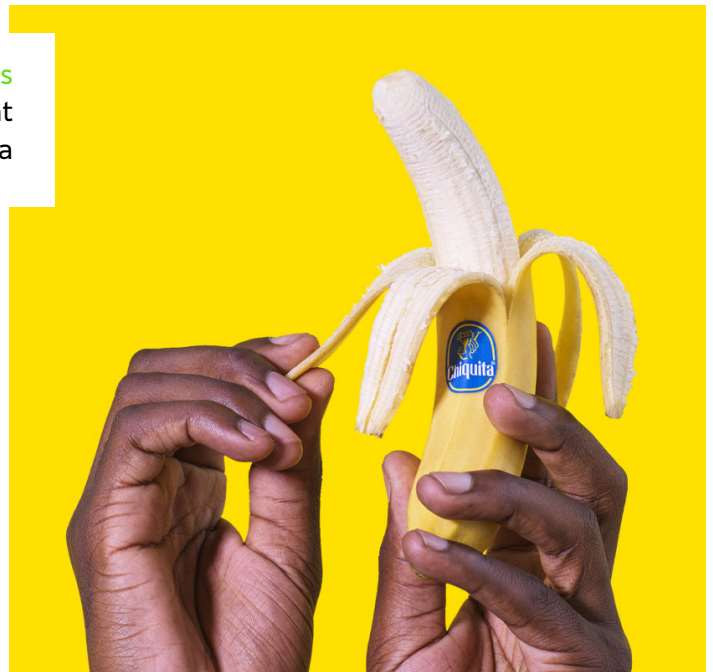


Debates
