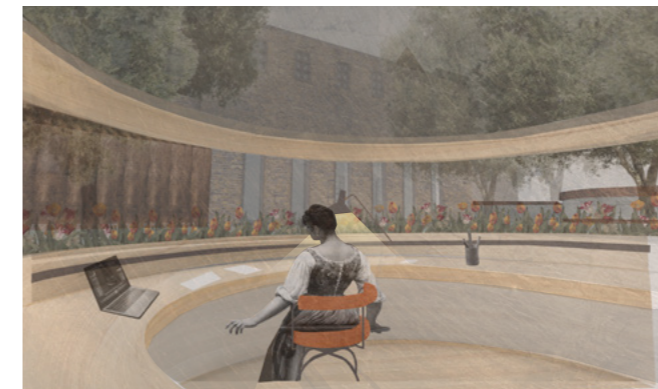


Big Wins

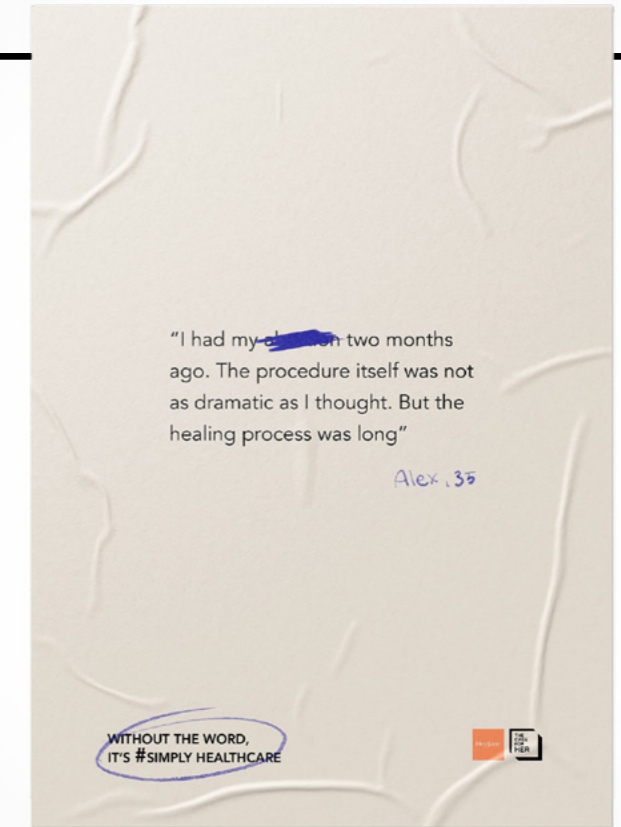

Honorary Doctorates



Robin Baker OBE, RCA, FRSA

Professor Robin Baker was previously Director of Computing and then awarded the first chair of computing at the Royal College of Art, and until 2010 held the position as the Director of Ravensbourne.

He was pivotal in Ravensbourne's relocation from its original Chislehurst site, to its current home in North Greenwich, a move which has earned him recognition both in the UK and internationally. He has been responsible for spearheading innovation and reform within the building itself, in the adoption of new technology and within the

curriculum. These reforms have helped to create a leading educational experience fit for the 21st Century.

Following the relocation to Greenwich he worked in Kazakhstan, China and Nigeria developing a creative higher education provision based upon the Ravensbourne model.

Robin was awarded the Order of the British Empire by the Queen for his contribution to Higher Education. He now works as a consultant to Higher Education and the digital industries, with a particular focus on education in urban regeneration.



Walter Murch

Award-winning film editor, sound mixer, writer, and director Walter Murch's name is synonymous with the film industry. Throughout his career, he has become one of the most famous and respected film editors after spending more than six decades at the helm of modern cinema.

Born in New York City, Walter first earned recognition for his early work editing and sound mixing on Francis Coppola's *The Rain People* in 1969. Since his early days, he has gone on to work on some classic films like *Apocalypse Now*, *The Godfather I, II, and III*, *The Conversation* and *The English Patient*.

His legendary work earned him nine Academy Award nominations, which included six for editing picture and three for sound mixing. He has won three Oscars: one for Best Sound on *Apocalypse Now* and two for Best Film Editing and Best Sound for his work on *The English*

Patient. He has also received nine BAFTA nominations resulting in three BAFTA wins, including one for Best Film Editing and Best Sound on *The Conversation* and Best Film Editing on *The English Patient*.

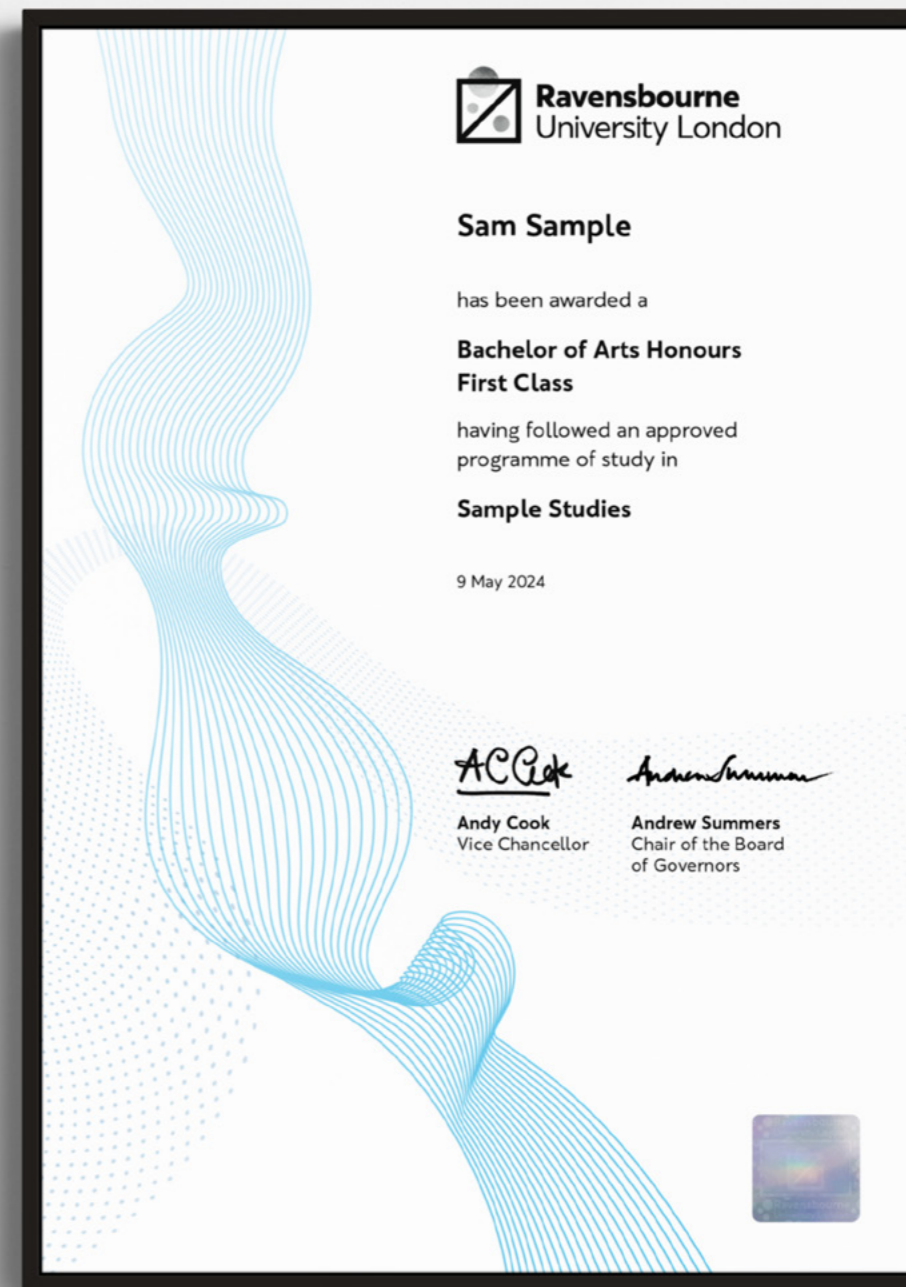
Along with film editing, Walter has been highly influential in film editing and function theory. He has developed new systems and means for editing in the analogue world, all while serving as an early pioneer for electronic editing. He became the first editor to receive an Academy Award (*The English Patient*) for a film edited electronically, using Avid's Media Composer.

Most recently, Walter was a supervising editor on William Kentridge's nine-episode series *Natural History of the Studio*, which will premiere at this year's Venice Biennale and on 3 March 2024 Walter was granted a Career Achievement Award by the American Cinema Editors.

Your certificate

We are proud to award you with our newly redesigned degree certificate.

The new certificate features a design inspired by the two rivers of Ravensbourne's history. The lines flowing along the left of the certificate represent the flow of the River Ravensbourne, from where the University gets its name. The dotted pattern winding across from left to right represents the River Thames as it curves around the Greenwich Peninsula, which has been Ravensbourne's home since 2010.
