Honorary Doctorates



Thomas Heatherwick CBE

Thomas is a globally-celebrated, visionary designer and fierce advocate for bringing joy, interest and humanity to our cities.

Over the past 30 years he has designed soulful new districts, cultural landmarks and transport infrastructure across six continents, and now also campaigns to stop the epidemic of harmful, boring buildings that surround us all. These ideas are captured in his bestselling book 'Humanise: A Maker's Guide to Building Our World', published worldwide in multiple languages and editions.

Thomas founded his studio in 1994 to bring together architecture, urban planning, product design and interiors into a single workspace. The studio seeks to design public projects which embrace and celebrate the complexities of the real world.

From their studios in London and Shanghai, the team is currently working on over 30 projects in ten countries, including Seoul's Nodeul Island; London Olympia; a new school for sustainable design in Bogotá; a mixed-use neighbourhood in Miami; and Singapore's Changi Airport's Terminal 5 in collaboration with KPF.

Previous projects include Azabudai Hills, a new neighbourhood in the centre of Tokyo; Little Island, a floating public park and performance space in New York City; Google's first ground-up campus in California; the London 2012 Olympic Cauldron; the Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa in Cape Town; and Xi'an CCBD, an astonishing new retail district in China.

Thomas and his team also run one of the largest educational programmes of any single art or design company in Britain.

Thomas has been appointed a Commander of the Order of the British Empire, a Royal Academician and in 2004 became the youngest Royal Designer for Industry. He is a leading global campaigner and lectures widely, including TED talks and broadcasts.



Jay Osgerby OBE

Jay Osgerby is widely recognised for his innovative contributions to contemporary design. He received a first-class degree in Industrial and Furniture Design at Ravensbourne University London (then Ravensbourne College of Art and Design), before going on to study Architecture at the Royal College of Arts where he met Edward Barber. Together, they founded one of the UK's most dynamic creative studios, Barber Osgerby.

Described as a "British design phenomenon" by the Financial Times, the studio has collaborated with some of the world's most progressive companies and boasts a diverse output that encompasses architecture, interiors, sculpture, product and exhibition design.

Jay has led projects ranging from the iconic Loop table for Isokon to the 100% recyclable TipTon Chair for Vitra, furniture for Cappellini, and lighting for Hermès and Louis Vuitton. Jay has received numerous accolades, including the Jerwood Prize in 2004 and Royal Designers

for Industry status in 2007. In 2013, he was appointed to the Order of the British Empire for services to the design industry, and in 2015, awarded the London Design Medal. His studio's work is held in the permanent collections of the V&A and the Design Museum in London, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Art Institute of Chicago, the Olympic Museum in Switzerland, and the Vitra Design Museum.

In 2001, Jay co-founded Universal Design Studio to operate alongside Barber Osgerby. Focused on workspaces, hospitality, retail and culture, the multi-award winning studio has become one of the world's most innovative creative design consultancies. In 2012, he co-launched the strategy-led industrial design consultancy Map Project Office, recognised by Fast Company as one of the 'Most Innovative Companies'. The studio has collaborated with forwardthinking organisations including Google, Group Lotus and IBM, contributing to quantum-centric supercomputing. In 2026, Barber Osgerby will celebrate its 30th anniversary.

Your certificate

We are proud to award you with our degree certificate, whose design is inspired by the two rivers of Ravensbourne's history. The lines flowing along the left of the certificate represent the flow of the River Ravensbourne, from where the University gets its name. The dotted pattern winding across from left to right represents the River Thames as it curves around the Greenwich Peninsula, which has been Ravensbourne's home since 2010.



The University Mace

The Mace is the symbol of governing authority and is carried before the Presiding Officer at graduation ceremonies.

The modern design of Ravensbourne University London's Mace reflects the mission and vision of the university to develop people, ideas and innovation, all in collaboration with industry.

That the Mace was designed by BA (Hons) Product Design alumna, Anna Eerdmans, is a testament to the pedigree of innovative design with which the University has become synonymous.

Indeed, the design of Ravensbourne's Mace takes into careful consideration symbolism, heritage and local representation.

The Mace pays homage to Ravensbourne's origin and its founding members. The three-prong base represents the three colleges, Bromley School of Art, Beckenham School of Art and Sidcup Art College. These colleges combined to form Ravensbourne College of Art and Design in 1962, before Ravensbourne was awarded its university status in 2018.

Another prominent feature is the dome on top of the Mace, which takes inspiration from the famous Greenwich Observatory dome, representing technical advancement, growth, and learning. The cubed section of the Mace represents Ravensbourne's iconic logo and the sun is a symbol of creativity and learning.
