- Listen to and involve staff, students and contractors in safety decisions.
- Ensure our suppliers and contractors meet our safety and environmental expectations, including responsible waste management, energy efficiency and pollution prevention.

Everyone at Ravensbourne - staff, students, contractors and visitors - has a role in keeping our community safe and environmentally responsible. We encourage everyone to care for themselves, each other and the environment, enabling everyone to raise concerns if something seems wrong or unsafe.
